2. Bonus

The bonus (calculated from the remaining amount of approved remuneration budget) will be allocated to directors by which the Board of Directors is authorized to determine the conditions, the details, and the rate of bonus payment as appropriate together with consideration of the Company's performance outcomes. In addition, the amount of bonus being allocated to each director depends on the accountability, performance and the participation in the meeting. The Executive Director will not receive any director's bonus, however.
